NOTICE OF COMMITTEE OF ADJUSTMENT HEARING

The Stratford Committee of Adjustment will consider the following application at a hearing to be held on Wednesday, September 18, 2024 at 4:00 p.m. in the Stratford City Council Chamber (upper level), located at 1 Wellington Street, Stratford.

A24-24 – 460 HURON STREET – A. BURNETT

The purpose of application A24-24 is to permit an additional residential dwelling unit in the basement of the existing single detached dwelling. The effect of application A24-24 is the expansion of a legal non-conforming use to facilitate an additional dwelling unit within an existing single detached dwelling below the first storey.

Permission Requested:

1. Regulation 7.3.2.1. – To permit an additional dwelling unit below the first storey of the existing single detached dwelling.

If a person or public body that files an appeal of a decision of the City of Stratford Committee of Adjustment in respect of the application does not make written submissions to the City of Stratford Committee of Adjustment before it gives or refuses the application, the Ontario Land Tribunal may dismiss the appeal.

If you wish to be notified of the decision of the City of Stratford Committee of Adjustment in respect of the application, you must make a written request to the Alternate Secretary-Treasurer, Stratford Committee of Adjustment, Alexander Burnett, 82 Erie Street, 3rd Floor Stratford, ON N5A 2M4. This will also entitle you to be advised of a possible Ontario Land Tribunal hearing. Even if you are the successful party, you should request a copy of the decision since the Stratford Committee of Adjustment decision may be appealed to the Ontario Land Tribunal by the applicant, the Minister or a specified person or public body”.

BACK TO SCHOOL SAFETY

With students preparing to head back to school in September, vehicle and pedestrian traffic will soon be increasing across the City. As the safety of all pedestrians is of utmost importance, we ask that everyone please drive carefully and always remember to:

- Stay alert around school buses and in school safety zones.
- Obey proper rules at crossing guard locations and only proceed when crossing guards and pedestrians have completely crossed the road.
- Always be alert & aware of pedestrians - drive slowly & be cautious around schools and crossings.
- Limit any distractions, remove headphones, put away cellphones and other distractions when crossing the street, make eye contact with drivers & pedestrians when in crossing zones.
- Look for signage and adhere to school zone areas identified as 'no parking' or 'no stopping'.
- Follow all instructions from the crossing guards, always wait for the crossing guard to stop traffic and indicate that it is safe to cross.

The City's crossing guards and parking enforcement officers work every day to uphold pedestrian and vehicle safety. We ask that you do your part to help make sure everyone stays safe.
